We have a great opportunity to represent our guild, get information to the public, and recruit new members at the Trades Day at Naper Settlement on Sun. July 27 from 1-4pm.


They will be showcasing trades and skills that were common in the 1800's.

Re:new is a 501c3 (non-profit) sewing microenterprise located in Wheaton. In cooperation with World Relief, twenty women are employed to sew bags, purses, wallets, and small household items. All of the women are refugees; they and their families have escaped political or religious persecution in their home country, and have been granted official refugee status from the U.S. government.

Re:new gives these women an opportunity to learn a skill, practice English, and begin life in community. The creative and beautiful bags they make are made almost exclusively with donated fabric. If you have quality decorator weight fabrics, they would greatly appreciate them. Quality, in-style cottons are also accepted.

Anniversary Signature Quilt




